- Q. 1. What is the main purpose of mankind? A. Mankind's main purpose is to glorify God and to enjoy him forever.
- Q. 2. What rule has God given to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him?
- A. The Word of God, which is contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments. is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy him.
