Key Responsibilities

- Maintain cleanliness and order in all offices, meeting spaces, worship areas, and classrooms

- Maintain clear walkways to prevent slips and falls, especially during inclement weather (compliant with OSHA general duty clause).
- Complete seasonal deep cleaning projects.

Health & Safety Compliance

• Follow OSHA and local health department regulations for janitorial practices and workplace safety.

- Ensure all walkways, emergency exits, and fire extinguishers are accessible and clearly marked.
- Conduct periodic safety checks and report hazards or maintenance needs.
- Maintain Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for all cleaning products used.
- Use and store chemicals in accordance with OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard

Other Duties

- Work flexible hours for special services and events (holidays, weddings, funerals).
- Communicate with staff and volunteers about building needs or concerns.
- Assist with seasonal decorating or church-related projects as needed.

Qualifications
